OBJECTIVE

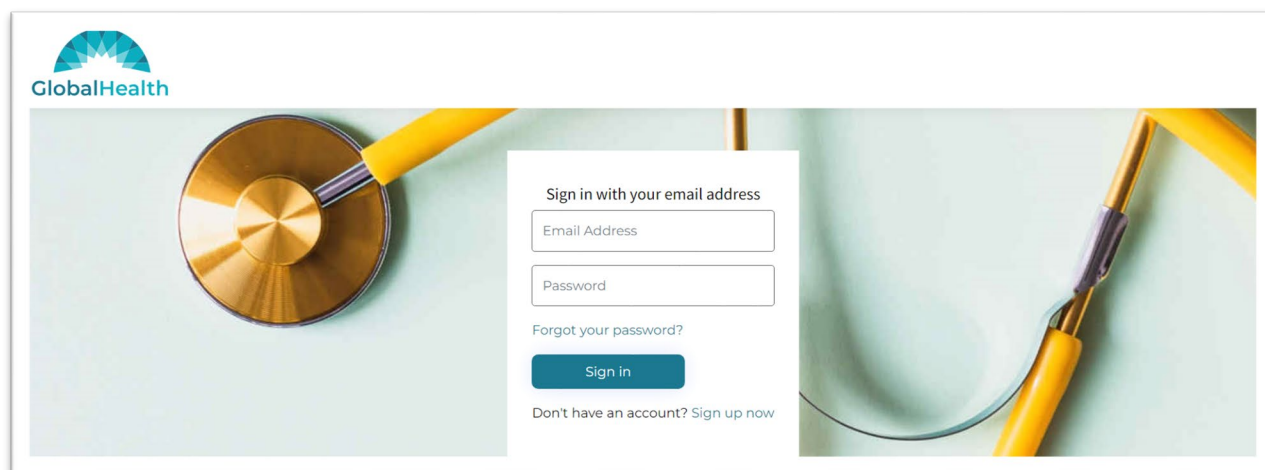
The goal of this user guide is to provide step-by-step instructions for Quality Portal External User Registration.

All references to the Quality Portal will be referred to as 'The Portal' for the entirety of this document.

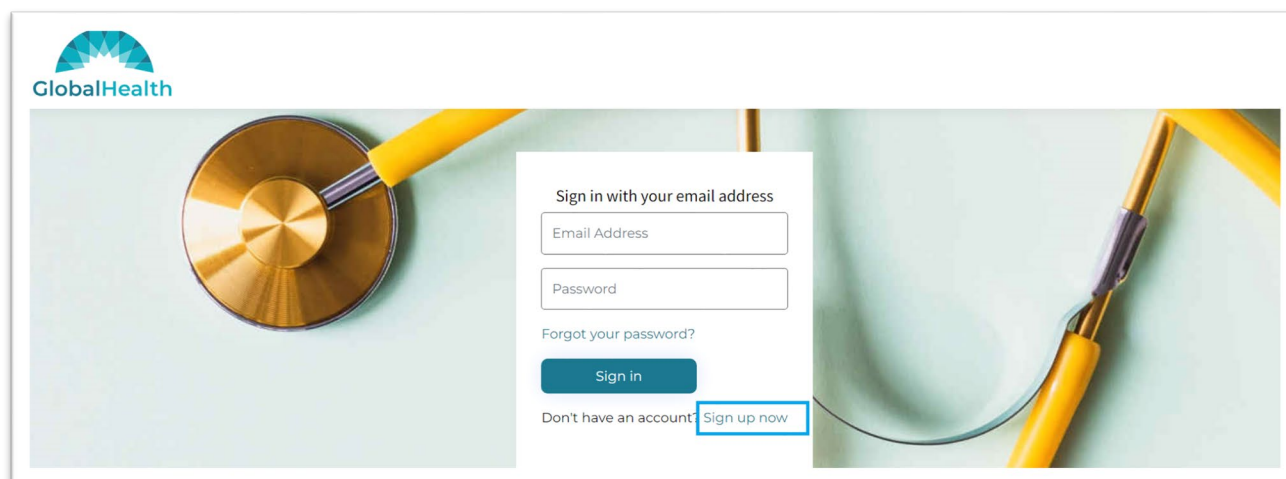
How to access registration page?

Navigation

1. Access quality portal application with URL <https://qualityportal.globalhealthportals.com/>



2. Click on the "Sign up now" link from login screen.



You will be navigated to the User Registration page.

3. Fill in all known information in the "Demographic Information" section.
4. Click on "Submit" button.

A successful application submission message is displayed, and a verification email will be sent to the email address provided after successfully completing the form.

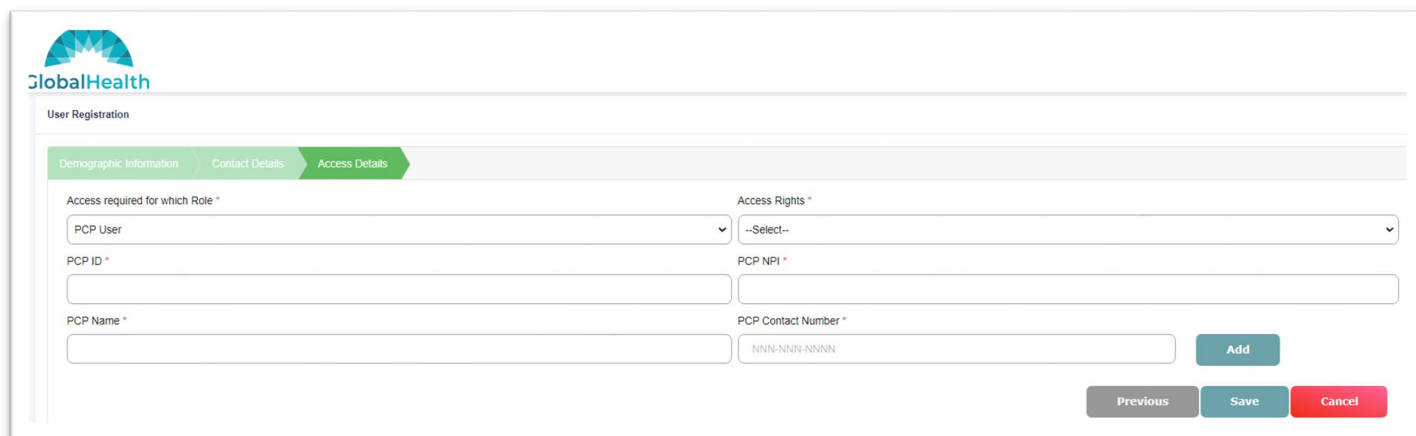

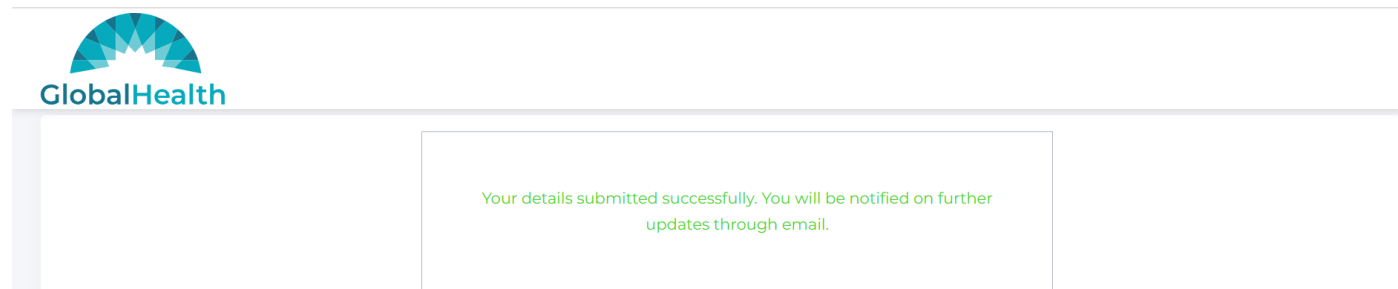

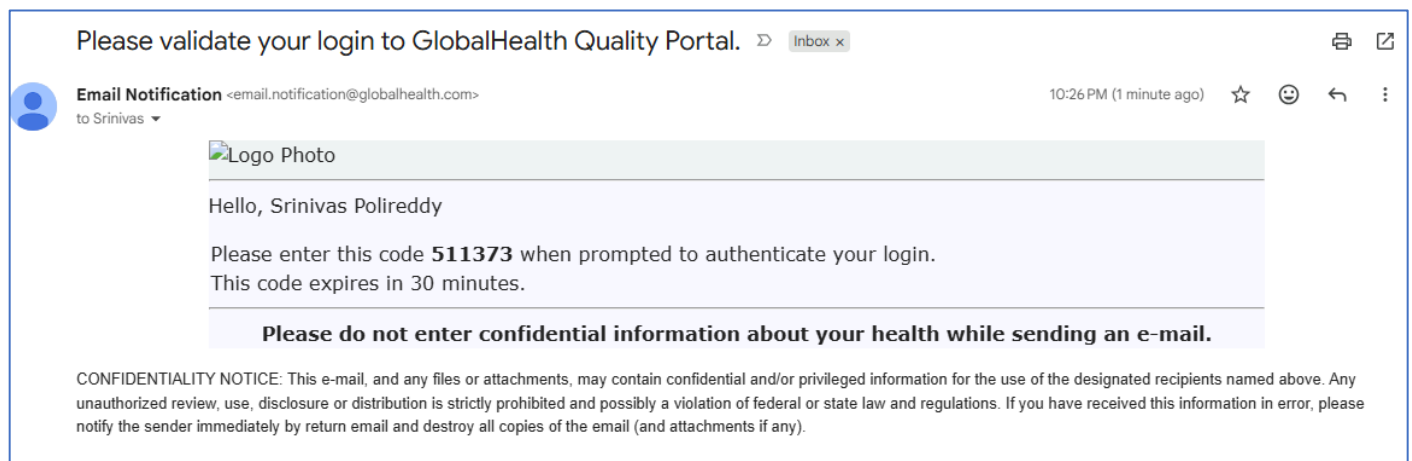
Sample of the Approval e-mail notification:



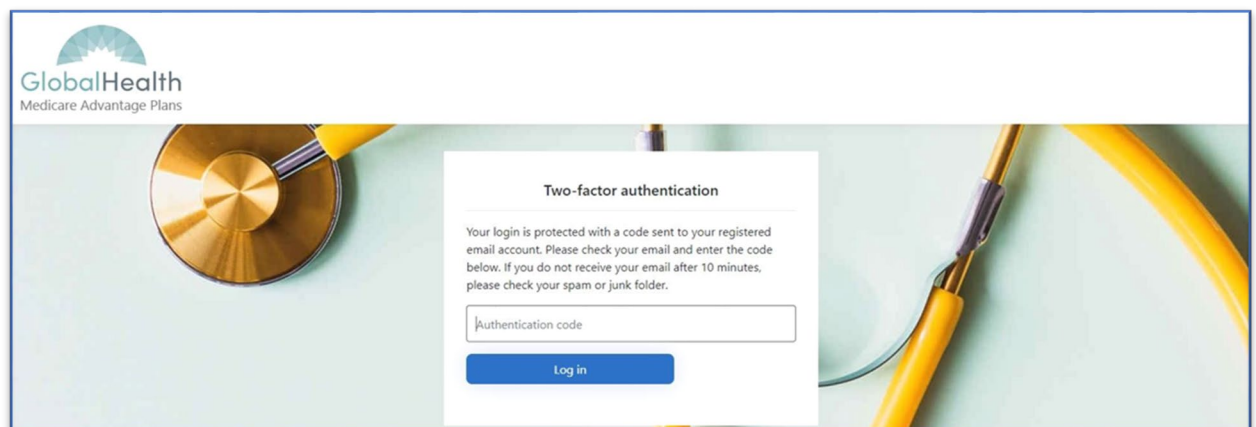
11. Click on Quality Portal application link that is received in email or open the browser and enter the Quality Portal application URL.



12. In the Email Address box: Enter the e-mail address that you used to register your account.
13. In the Password box: Enter the password that you created for your account.
14. Click on "Sign In" button
 - GlobalHealth uses Two Factor Authentication to protect all member and provider information.
 - The Quality Portal will send a confirmation code to the registered e-mail.

Once user is authenticated and logged into the system, user can see the application data such as star scores at measure level, entity level, descendants' stars scores, entity associated member details, part C measure gaps, upcoming and missed refills at entity level, etc..

NOTE: Data is produced in the application based on the logged in user role.
