

## Advanced Biosimilars-First Medical Preferred Drug List Medicare Part B Step Therapy

The GlobalHealth Advanced Biosimilars-First Medical Preferred Drug List encourages utilization of clinically appropriate and lower net cost products within the following therapeutic drug classes. The GlobalHealth Advanced Biosimilars-first Medical Preferred Drug List applies to the listed products only and any other product may be available under a plan's medical benefit.

The listed preferred products must be used first. An exception process is in place for specific circumstances that may warrant a need for a non-preferred product. For example, this step therapy requirement does not apply to plan's members who are actively receiving treatment (i.e., members with a paid claim within the past 365 days) with non-preferred product on the GlobalHealth Advanced Biosimilars-first Medical Preferred Drug List.
